Digital Print Ready (File Dump) Instructions

Step 1:

Open your application

We use Adobe Photoshop, yet Elements or Lightroom can be used.

Please be aware that unless your colour settings are setup to our requirements and your monitor properly colour balanced your images could look different on screen verses printed. We are happy to supply you with a monitor test file and sample print generated from this file for you to check your monitor calibration.

Step 2:

Go to - file - New

Set up your new file as specified below:

Name: "filename".tif

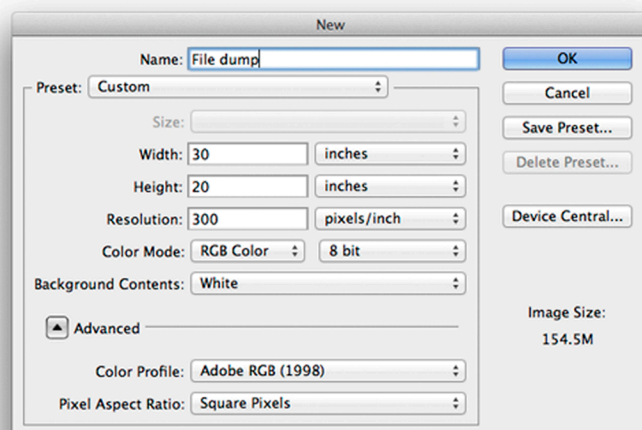
Preset size: Custom

Width: 30 inches

Height: 20 inches

Resolution: 300 pixels/Inch

Mode: RGB Colour, 8bit



Step 3:

Go to - File - Open. Find the file(s) you want printed. Select and open them. If you require your files to be a certain size it is best to pre-size them before you place them onto your file dump page.

With the first or largest image that you would like to print open, select the Move Tool from your Toolbar. Click and hold on your image, drag it onto your 20x30in file dump. With your first image on your file dump page you can reposition and rotate your image to suit. To be sure of the size and proportion of your image use your rulers and guides. When you have positioned your first image suitably, repeat the operation on your next image until your File dump page is full.

Step 4:

With no further editions to be made now is the time to flatten your file.

To do this (In Photoshop) select Layer - Flatten image.

Now you are unable to move your images individually.

Your file size will now be approximately 154.5mb.

Save your File dump as a TIF or JPEG.

Your Digital File dump is now ready for printing.

This file is generally too large to email, so copy to a CD/DVD, USB/Memory stick, or send to us via a file transfer website eg:
